


GUIDELINES FOR DOWNLOAD FILES


Primarily use PDF files on your website.

Word documents or JPEG images should rarely, if ever, be used as downloads.

Create an RTF for ALL PDF files you upload. This is for ADA compliance. RTFs download as Word documents (editable by the user, but will not affect the file online).


DO NOT
place your PDFs
inside a Text
Window
component!






- 1. When editing your page, click here to add your Downloads component. Choose "Downloads" from the Component Type drop-down menu.
- 2. Once your component is created, click on it to access the "Add Download" option.






- 1. Click here to upload the PDF you want to add to your site.
- 2. Or, if you have multiple PDF files, you can Bulk Upload them.
 - a. This WILL NOT create the RTF file you will need to go back to each PDF and manually choose to add an RTF.
- 3. Your list of downloads. They can be rearranged to a new order by clicking and dragging.
 - a. MAKE SURE the RTF stays JUST BELOW its PDF. Otherwise the formatting on the webpage will look off.


- 1. Write the name you want displayed for your PDF.
- 2. **OPTIONAL**: if you want the PDF to appear or disappear on certain dates, add those here.
- 3. Choose the file you want to upload. IT MUST BE A PDF.
 No periods in the file name.
- 4. Keep this box
 checkmarked to
 automatically create an
 RTF file of your PDF.
- 5. Click Save, or Save And New if uploading more files.





If you forget to create an RTF, OR if you bulk upload files and need to create the RTFs:

- 1. Click the title of the PDF in the list.
- 2. Scroll down to the "Create RTF Version" button. Click on it to create your RTF.
 - a. Depending on the PDF file size, this can take a little time.
 - b. Any other changes made to the Download will not save after clicking the RTF button, so save your work!
- 3. Your RTF will appear at the top of the list. MAKE SURE to click and drag it below its PDF version.



- 1. DO NOT add a PDF in a Text Window!
- 2. Adding a PDF this way will only create the PDF link with no way to add an RTF link. That is out of ADA compliance!
