



All 4 Youth Fact Sheet



Vision Statement

We envision a community where all children's behavioral health needs are met. Barriers will be removed and all children and families will have access to a seamless system that promotes a positive healthy environment in which to live and learn.

Mission Statement

Our mission is to have an integrated system of care that ensures all children in Fresno County have access to behavioral health services to support their social, emotional and behavioral needs and promote health, well-being and resiliency.

Types of Services: Behavioral health services are determined by the clinician and may include the following: Individual counseling, family counseling, group services, case management/collateral services (support to primary caregiver on behalf of youth) and behavioral coaching (rehabilitation).

Services are provided to: Children and youth 0-22 years of age and their families.

Service location: In the school, community and/or in the home.

Staff:

Youth Care Specialists: Provide groups and support to youth who may need assistance with managing their behavior and provide case management/support to youth and family who are working with an All 4 Youth clinician. Youth Care Specialists can serve as the primary provider to a youth or as a secondary service provider in addition to a clinician. Youth Care Specialists have a B.A/B.S degree or higher. Youth must meet eligibility under medical necessity to access Youth Care Specialist services.

Intervention Specialists: Provide support to youth who may need assistance with managing their behavior and provide case management/support to youth and family who are working with an All 4 Youth counselor. Intervention Specialists can serve as the primary provider to a youth or as a secondary service provider in addition to a clinician. Intervention Specialists have a minimum of a B.A/B.S degree or higher. Youth must meet eligibility under medical necessity to access Intervention Specialist services.

Clinician I and II: All clinicians are registered with the Board of Behavioral Sciences and are designated as an associate or a licensed: Marriage and Family Therapist, Clinical Social Worker, or a Professional Clinical Counselor. Clinician I's are unlicensed or newly licensed clinical staff. Clinician II's are licensed for 2 or more years.

Clinicians will conduct an initial assessment for each referral. Following the initial assessment the Clinician will coordinate which services (individual, family, group therapy or rehabilitations services) best fit the need of each youth and family.

Referral Process:

Referrals can be generated from multiple sources including self-referral, school staff, family members and outside agencies. Referrals can be made by completing a Request for Consultation form or calling the All 4 Youth line at 443-4800. Completed paper Requests for Consultation can be emailed to All4Youth@fcoe.org

Once a referral has been made, insurance will be verified by All 4 Youth staff and a clinician will contact the family/caregiver of the youth to initiate follow-up. In order to facilitate communication and coordination around services between school staff and clinicians, parents will be asked to sign an Authorization to Release Information.

Information Sharing:

The All 4 Youth program operates under a medical model and must adhere to the privacy and confidentiality regulations of HIPAA (Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act). Privacy information can only be shared with people or entities that the youth and/or care providers have identified within a signed Release of Information on file within the youth's All 4 Youth medical record. In cases of imminent danger and/or risk of safety to persons or the public, service providers are permitted to share minimum information necessary to prevent and/or reduce the potential risk of harm.

Service costs:

There may be a cost for services provided depending on the student's insurance status. If there is a fee for services, families are informed of fees prior to services being given and in some instances families may qualify for payment plan.

Substance use/abuse services:

All 4 Youth is not currently providing substance use disorders, however, appropriate evaluation and referrals will be made as needed.
