


The Earlier We Start, The Farther They'll Go

Because all babies are different, they rarely do the same thing at the same age. As a result, it's not unusual for families to have questions or concerns about their child's development. You may wonder:


Why isn't my baby talking? Why isn't my baby crawling? Why is my toddler throwing a tantrum? Why doesn't my child respond to me?

- 1. Call Central Valley Regional Center at (559) 276-4300, for an assessment of your child's developmental needs. Families can refer their own child. You do not need a doctor's referral.
- 2. After qualification, you may request the CITI Kids Program from your Regional Center Worker.
- 3. A teacher from CITI Kids will contact you to set up the first home visit to discuss your child's needs, goals and what kind of program will best suit your family.
- 4. You may request support and information from the Family Resource Center, which is part of the CITI Kids Program.
