The funds are designed to meet and support the special educational and culturally related academic needs of American Indians and Alaska Natives, so that students can achieve at the same challenging State performance standards expected by all students. The purpose of this survey is to assess the effectiveness of the Title VI program activities and to determine what action needs to be taken, if any, to increase parental participation. This year, our grant has allowed us to fund an additional 13 instructional aides to serve K-12 students at 44 different school sites.
