Minimum Qualifications

To become a school bus driver you must:

- Be at least 18 years old
- Meet minimum physical requirements (MCSA 587/5876)
- Possess a valid Class A or B driver license or an instruction permit of the appropriate class
- Have a clean background & driving record (DMV K4)

Training/Testing

- 1. School Bus Original Class (min 20 hours)
- 2. Medical Examination Certificate
- 3. DMV/CDL Permit & Endorsement Testing
- 4. DMV/CDL Permit Issued
- 5. CHP Written & First Aid Test
- 6. Apply on edjoin.org and Schedule Interview
- 7. HR process and background check
- 8. Obtain Behind-the-wheel training (min 20 hours)
- 9. Successfully pass BTW testing with CHP

All classroom and behind-the-wheel instruction must be given by a California State Certified School Bus Driver Instructor, or under their direction.
