1. Welcome:

Principal Aiello started the meeting started at 9:03am. The minutes from the December SART meeting were reviewed and approved by the group.

2. Spotlight on Student Success: Science Olympiad

The Science Olympiad team (7-12) was introduced. The advisor shared an informational flyer and discussed what this group gets to do and compete. Students shared their personal experiences with Science Olympiad. Students liked the 7-12 model. More practices this year for students to work on their project. Fundraisers help support the team in acquiring kits, entry fees, etc.

3. Students Reports:

a. BHS

Noah Renteria shared Pep and Cheer placed first at the division I level. Competition cheer will be traveling to Florida for their competition. Academic Decathlon competed last Saturday. BHS placed 9th overall. Yesterday (2/4) was the annual Matt Mueller blood drive, where over 300 people donated blood.

Today (2/5) is a national signing day. Tomorrow our wrestling team will travel to Clovis High for the big dual. Girls basketball program is very competitive under coach Wall.

b. ASI

Dodge shared about several fundraisers. The annual Canned Food Drive brought in 2,100 cans and food items for needy families in the community. The Jingle Bell run was a huge and successful fundraiser.

Winter sports – Girls soccer won the league. Class of 2024 won the last rally.

Academic Awards: 558 students received high honor roll. 39% of students earned high honor roll and principal's honor roll.

Cookie fundraiser is going on right now.

4. Counselors Reports:

a. BHS

Jeff Hodges shared that registration planning is underway. Students in 9th and 10th grade have attended session to prepare for registration. CART and CTE presentations were made to all sophomores. Next week, counselors will be teaching the 8th grade lesson in AB classes at Alta Sierra. Sophomore/Junior parent night is this Thursday night starting at 5:45pm in the LLH. This session is open to all parents.

b. ASI

MacKenzie Mennucci shared about registration at ASI. Information will be posted on the school website. On February 21 there will be an Open House for counselors and parents. Presentations at the elementary schools will begin in March. Two parent orientations for incoming 7th graders will be in March, one will be held at ASI the other at Tarpey.

5. SART Topic: Cultural Proficiency

Principal Aiello shared the plan for BHS to work on cultural proficiency. The last few years, we've worked hard with our students through Human Relations Day, rallies, kindness movement. This year, we focused more on our staff to bring understanding about diversity and culture. We are sending a team of teacher leaders to the Museum of Tolerance.

Ms. Sarah Tozlian, Activities Director shared about Harmony, a tradition that we have had for the last 21 years. Harmony is a talent show that showcase our special needs students and general education along with our various clubs. This is a celebration of diversity and unique talents of our students. The opening video of Harmony was shared with the group. She shared pictures of the cultural displays in the library. Various clubs took turn putting artifacts in the library.

Mrs. Kia Yang, Deputy Principal shared about her personal story. Staff members are encouraged to share their story and help staff understand more about each other. ASI is also highlighting stories from staff members.

6. Principals Reports:

a. BHS

Principal Joe Aiello shared that BHS hosted the Pep and Cheer CIF competition. BHS was the only school in division I that earned first place. Pep team defeated the Clovis North team that last Saturday also earned first place in division I. Another team that did very well is our Academic Decathlon team and earned 9th place overall. Accolades given to our Activities Director and leadership students for all their effort in putting great events. Our Matt Mueller blood drive was a huge success.
