<b>CLASS TIMES</b>	Daily (Monday – Thursday) 8:30 a.m. – 1:00 p.m.
<b>PURPOSE</b>	To make up failing grade(s) for grade promotion or graduation requirements. <b>NOTE: There will be in-class instruction for <u>selected courses only</u>. Please see your counselor.</b>
<b>NOTIFICATION</b>	Registration occurs at the student’s regular high school site. HS Counselor will register students. Parent Connect may be accessed to view student’s summer school schedule in late May.
<b>CREDIT RECOVERY ELIGIBILITY</b>	To be eligible to enroll in credit recovery, a student <b>must be an enrolled CUSD student <i>and</i></b> meet one of the following two criteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Must be an incoming student in grades 10 – 12 that <b><u>must repeat a course</u></b> due to D or F or</li> <li>▪ Must be deficient in credits/required courses for graduation.</li> </ul>
<b>ORIGINAL CREDIT ELIGIBILITY</b>	For a student to take an Original Credit course in Summer School, the student must meet the following three criteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Have an impacted schedule for the following school year <b><u>and</u></b></li> <li>▪ Possess a 3.0 or higher Semester GPA (unless otherwise indicated for exceptional circumstances) <b><u>and</u></b></li> <li>▪ Possess self-discipline, self-motivation, and be able to work independently</li> </ul>
<b>LUNCH</b>	Lunch will be provided to all students through the Summer Seamless program.

TRANSPORTATION	Will be provided from pre-selected elementary sites. See CUSD Website for details.
ATTENDANCE	<p>Students are required to attend full class hours daily Monday – Thursday.</p> <p><b><i>ONLY 2 DAYS OF INSTRUCTION CAN BE MISSED. Work must be made up. Any student missing more than two absences will be dropped after the 2<sup>nd</sup> absence.</i></b></p> <p><b>Absence</b> = Family vacation, court, illness, school sponsored function, being sent home for dress code or a conduct violation.</p>
STUDENT CONDUCT & DRESS CODE	<p><b>All Clovis Unified School District rules will be enforced during Summer School including CUSD Dress Code:</b></p> <p><b>Conduct:</b> Students are required to abide by the school code of conduct. Students who break the California Education Code are eligible for suspension. If a student is suspended, and the resulting effect is that they miss too many classes as defined by the summer school attendance policy, will be dropped after serving their suspension. <i>Zero tolerance offenses will be referred for further disciplinary action.</i></p> <p><b>Dress Code:</b> Students are required to comply with the district-wide dress code when attending course appointments. Students out of dress code will be sent home and marked absent.</p>
TRANSCRIPT	<p><b>Drop Procedures with no credits earned:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Drop before end of 1<sup>st</sup> week – Not recorded on HS Transcript</li> <li>● Drops after 1<sup>st</sup> week: Record Class with NG (No Grade)</li> </ul> <p>Once a course is completed, grades and credits will be posted on the students' transcript. <b><u>Summer School grade postings are permanent and may not be deleted.</u></b> Summer School courses may be repeated at the school site <b>ONLY</b> if the grade earned was a D or F.</p>
