STUDENT RECOGNITION GRADES 1st-6th

POSITIVITY AWARD

This award will be earned weekly from September to May for students who have exemplified that Positivity Project trait taught that week. Each teacher will submit 1 student per week that will be recognized on KRAV Action News which is broadcast throughout the campus daily. Students who earn the Positivity Award will receive a Bumper Sticker and be listed in the Raven Reporter.

EXEMPLARY ATTENDANCE AWARD

Exemplary attendance will be recognized each semester for students who have less than 3 absences and less than 2 unexcused tardies. Students with exemplary attendance for an entire year will receive a special certificate from Clovis Unified School District at the end of the 2nd semester.

ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE AWARD

Students who have shown proficiency in both English Language Arts (Reading, Language, and Writing) and Math for the semester will be recognized each semester. Students must demonstrate proficiency of 90% (3rd-6th Grades) or 85% (1st-2nd Grades) on ELA and Math assessments, including math facts given during the semester. This award combines the English Language Arts and Math Award into one award; students who earn this award are not eligible for the ELA or Math Award.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS AWARD

Students who have shown proficiency in ELA for the semester will be recognized each semester. Students must demonstrate proficiency of 90% (3rd-6th Grades) or 85% (1st and 2nd Grades) on ELA assessments during the semester.

MATH AWARD

Students who have shown proficiency in Math for the semester will be recognized each semester. Students must demonstrate proficiency of 90% (3rd-6th Grades) or 85% (1st and 2nd Grades) on Math assessments, including math facts given during the semester.

BUD RANK AWARD

Presented each semester to **two** (1st-3rd) and **three** (4th-6th) students from each class who exemplify hard work, effort, and determination to succeed, just like Mr. Bud Rank. The student(s) will be presented with a special Raven blue ribbon each semester at an awards assembly.

HONOR ROLL (4th-6th only)

The Honor Roll is a means of giving recognition to students based on scholastic achievement. Honor Roll students are recognized each semester at an awards assembly. The qualification requirements for the Honor Roll are:

- ♦ No D's or F's on the report card.
- No N's or U's on the report card.
- The following grade point averages:

- ♦ The grade point averages are based on grades for Reading, Mathematics, Language/Writing, Spelling, Science, and Social Science.

RAVEN ATHLETIC AWARDS (Grades 4th-6th only)

Students receive a certificate of participation for membership on any Bud Rank athletic team at the end of each sports season. Trophies will be presented to several students from each athletic team for individual recognition at the coach's discretion.

BUD RANK BLOCK BR (Grades 5th & 6th only)

The Bud Rank Block BR Award is the highest award a student may earn. Students in grades 5-6 are eligible for this award. The criteria for earning this award reflect a broad base of participation, achievement, and service. In order to earn the BLOCK BR, a student must accrue points in the following areas:
