Traffic & Safety

We are seeing an increase in dangerous situations at drop off, pick up, and in the crosswalks. Here are some important reminders to keep all students safe:

Campus opens at 7:35. Dropping off closer to that time ensures you and your child aren't rushed, and drop off isn't in the middle of the parking lot to avoid being late.

Dropping off in the middle of the street when traffic is backed up isn't safe.

Drop off along Sanders Ave west of campus and let students walk across the grass.

While at crosswalks drivers should never direct students to cross when a school employee is on Crosswalk Duty.

When students are crossing, do not enter the crosswalk they are in even to make a quick right turn.

Dropping off in the middle of the parking lot isn't safe, and it backs up traffic.

Dropping off in disabled parking when you do not have a disabled placard is illegal.

Plan ahead and leave earlier; most safety issues occur after the bell has rung. Is a tardy more important than the safety of your child and other children?

Please drive, drop off, and pick up like your child and their friends go to school here.

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
