Clovis High School awards an **Academic Block C** to students who (1) earn a minimum weighted G.P.A of 3.75, (2) are involved in a co-curricular activity or club at Clovis High School, and (3) exhibit appropriate citizenship. Students must apply each semester based on previous semester grades by picking up an application in the YALE office. Students who receive Academic Block "C" are honored at the Academic Awards Ceremony in the spring.

Program Description

Becoming an Advanced Studies Scholar of Distinction is the highest academic honor a student can receive at graduation, recognized as the most academically powerful students.

National Honor Society (NHS) is a prestigious organization that recognizes high school students who reflect outstanding character, leadership, and community service.

The California Scholarship Federation (CSF) is a state honor society which requires its members to take college prep classes and maintain a high GPA. Eligibility is based on a point system.

Eligibility

Maintain a minimum UC weighted GPA of 4.1 over five semesters.

Complete at least five Advanced Placement classes in high school.

Pass at least two Advanced Placement examinations, with a score of 3 or higher, by the end of junior year.

No application required. Students are automatically identified during their senior year.

Open to 10th, 11th, and 12th.

Must have an overall weighted GPA of 3.5

In addition to GPA, student are also evaluated on basis of service, leadership, and character.

9th - 12th are eligible to apply with grades from the previous semester (9th grade students have to wait until they have their first semester grades).

Application, transcript, and \$10 contribution must be submitted during the membership drive.

Life Membership is achieved by having CSF membership 4 or more semesters sophomore through senior year (one of which must be during the senior year).
