Welcome, Introductions & Purpose

Principal, Dr. Shapiro welcomed all attendees to the meeting and explained the purpose of IDAC.

Measure A

Dr. Shapiro discussed Measure A on the upcoming ballot in November 2024. He explained the reason behind the bond and how it will be spent if approved. Safety and Energy Upgrades, Clovis South, Modernizations on many School sites (roofs, flooring, classrooms). Dr. Shapiro explained that it would not raise the tax rate and would use the same tax rate we have now, which would be lower than neighboring schools.

Shapiro asked if parents had any questions, and he answered a question that was asked about what the safety upgrades in the bond include. He discussed the alarm, bullet proof glass and cameras.

School Safety

Mr. Bowns explained the process of school safety, which includes all guests checking in at the front office through Raptor and all visitors receiving a visitor's badge. Doors will remain locked facing the street and the end of the building. Interior doors are unlocked for students during the passing period.

Mr. Bowns discussed the Catapult system and how it can perform drills, evacuations, lock downs and shelter in place. All staff can access Catapult from their phone, which will notify the district office, CNEC staff and parents. Teachers can take student attendance during an emergency.

Academic Data 2023-24 School Year

Dr. Shapiro went over the demographics for Clovis North and Granite Ridge and the grades that tested were ELA / Math 7th, 8th and 11th grades. Dr. Shapiro went over the results of testing within the District and discussed areas of growth for CN and GR.

Alicynne Chaney discussed the new cell phone policy and how it was implemented in classrooms and that the support from parents and teachers has been so beneficial. She also discussed the new tardy process at CN and GR. Music is played when the passing bell rings to get students headed to class. Teachers will lock the door when the tardy bell sounds. GR tardy students report to SSO and CN tardy students report to front office. 1st tardy is a warning, 2nd tardy is lunch detention, future tardies will progress in discipline.

Dress code is being implemented; Admin has made a pledge that students will be treated with respect when dress coded.

Class meetings were held at the start of the school year where Administration discussed school policies, reminded students to take care of one another (Code of the North). Alicynne discussed anonymous reporting and that students were encouraged to use it when necessary.

Dr. Shapiro discussed the site feedback on the new tardy system and cell phone policy, which has been overwhelmingly positive.
