In Destination Imagination® (DI) student teams collaborate to learn 21st Century Skills through challenges that foster creative and critical thinking. Teams solve open-ended Challenges and learn important life skills including time management, presentation skills, teamwork, and creative/critical thinking.

Who: Students K-12 on teams of 2-7 members. Each team needs an adult Team Manager who helps students stay on track.

What: 6 new Challenges are released each year developed by a team of educators and industry experts. The areas of focus include: Technical, Scientific, Fine Arts, Improvisational, Engineering and Service Learning. There is also a non-competitive Early Learning Challenge that allows kids to build social and problem solving skills.

When: Each season takes place from September through May. Teams typically spend 4 to 6 months developing and practicing their Challenge solutions.

Where: Regional Tournaments typically take place at local schools, and teams can advance to State and Global Finals tournaments.
