BLOCK Y GUIDELINES, DETAILS, AND REQUIRED SIGNATURES

The Block "Y" Award is an award that recognizes students involved in all areas of the school. The Block "Y" can be earned by all fourth, fifth and sixth grade students and is available one time per year. The criteria for this award reflects well-rounded participation and service, as well as achievement. Block "Y" recipients will be honored at our Block "Y" award ceremony at the end of the school year. In keeping with the spirit of the Clovis Unified School District philosophy to be the best you can be, the areas and activities in which students can earn points have been grouped into these three domains: Mind, Body and Spirit.

- Mind: Activities in this domain have to do with intellectual and artistic development.
- > Body: Activities and requirements in this domain have to do with physical fitness and athletics.
- > Spirit: The activities grouped in this domain have to do with character development. They are designed to provide opportunities for the development of such character attributes as caring for and service to others, active citizenship, cooperativeness, responsibility, and dedication.

In order to receive this award, a student need not be the "star" of his or her activity, but he/she must be an active and enthusiastic participant in the activities of the school, engaged in the pursuit of excellence, and have met certain standards of achievement and performance. Students who have been suspended and/or have incurred 5 turbulence tickets will be deemed ineligible to earn Block Y in the current school year. Individuals earning the prestigious Block Y award will receive an engraved plaque. Thereafter, a student will receive a medallion to be added to their plaque upon meeting the Block "Y" requirements once again. If a student has a plaque from another school already, they may choose to add a Young medallion to their existing plaque or accept a brand-new Young plaque.

It is not necessary for a student to participate in every activity to achieve this award. There are numerous ways a student may receive the Block "Y" award. It is suggested that students, along with their parents and teacher, discuss/plan for this award at the beginning of each year. This helps eliminate students over-extending themselves, while encouraging others to participate. In the sections that follow, specific details and requirements governing the earning of points in each category are discussed.

In order to receive points for each category, students must follow through on all commitments for each activity, and signatures must be provided to verify participation/completion for the indicated activities below. All on-site signatures will be gathered during our annual "Block Y Signing Day." Any off-campus signatures must be gathered prior to the due date for Block Y Forms. Students need to earn at least the minimum points indicated for each category to qualify for the award.

It is our hope that all students will actively pursue this award, making it a part of their planning for their total school experience. Whether or not the student actually receives this award, striving for it will hopefully enrich and enhance his or her educational foundation.
