Tips for Successful Course Registration

- Select each course as it appears on your worksheet
- Talk with your teachers about English, Math & Science recommendations. Math placement will be based off the Math Placement Test.
- Athletic PE requires a recommendation (Get a signature from their current head coach on the yellow worksheet)
- Courses are listed alphabetically in the "Available courses" table
- Be sure to select the correct course numbers
- Choose courses that are available based on your grade level; some courses are for 10th-12th grade only
- Select courses for the entire year (Semester 1 and Semester 2 Courses)
- Be sure to complete "Alternate" course selections as backups in case of scheduling conflicts
- Students may also turn in completed registration worksheet to CMS main office by 1/18/19
