Fees for the portion of the uniform that is kept must be paid by June 7th. For new girls that is \$305 and for returning girls that is \$157 (this will be more if you are ordering any new items). The \$20.00 for cheer camp shirts is due by June 24th. The remaining balance \$150 must be paid by October 8th.

The funds from fundraisers will be applied directly to the cheer account. The fees for items kept by the cheerleader will need to be paid for out of pocket.

Cheerleading does require us to purchase many items; it is the responsibility of each cheerleader's family to pay for these items. If a cheerleader decides to quit, or is removed for any reason from the team after items have been ordered, it is still their responsibility to pay for all of the items in full.

Cheerleading Application
