Final Exams will take place at Collinsville High School on December 20, 21, and 22. Each of the exam days ends with a lunch period., which allows students to leave campus early when they have no finals remaining for the day. Parents/Guardians wishing to have their student(s) excused before the regularly scheduled release times on exam days <u>MUST</u> complete this form for each child and <u>return it to the high school</u> office ON OR BEFORE December 16, 2021. Please note that transportation will not be provided for students leaving early. If a student needs to ride district transportation, that student will need to remain at school until the scheduled release time.

- *Students are required to be in attendance for all academic final exams:
- 1) during the class periods(s) and 2) on the days(s) assigned.
- *Students may leave the CHS campus at the scheduled time of the student's assigned lunch/study hall class period as long as they submit a parent/guardian signed permission form to the high school office. (No handwritten notes or requests via phone will be accepted for early dismissals).
- *Students are expected to be in class for the duration of the entire exam period.
- *Documentation from a medical physician is required for students missing any final exams.
- *If a student misses the first semester final exam(s) with a documented absence, s/he will be expected to make up these exams no later than the first three days of the second semester.
- *Students will not be permitted to complete semester exams before the scheduled exam period.
- *Students may not be permitted to make up final exams for unexcused absences that occur on a final.
