From the Principal's Desk

CMS Families,

I would like to thank everyone for their patience and support during this past month. There have been a number of e-learning days and changes due to masks. We have weathered this storm well with little disruption to the school day. Hopefully, the worst of the weather is behind us and we can focus on spring. I am looking forward to March and the hope for warmer weather.

Our basketball season is finished and wrestling will be winding down soon. Volleyball and bowling are in full swing and we will be gearing up for our upcoming track season.

One issue I would like for each family to discuss with their child is getting to class on time. Each quarter each student begins with 0 tardies. As time goes on, these numbers increase. Consequences begin with a warning at 5 tardies, 2 lunch detentions when they hit 10 tardies, an in-school suspension at 15, and then we begin using the STOP school when they get to 20. Over 700 of our students have never received a tardy. This tells me there is plenty of time to make it to class on time. If your child is having trouble making it to class, we need to know what the issue is.




