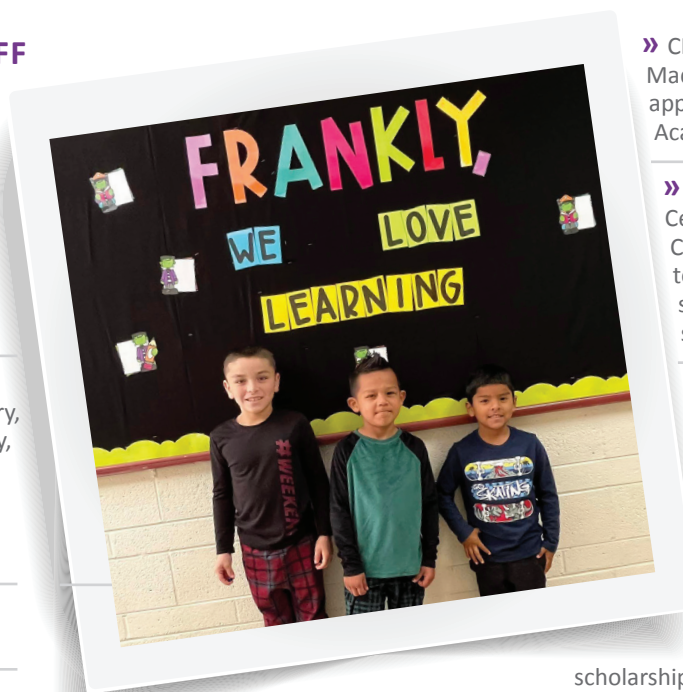
» CHS Senior Destiny Taylor honored as 2022-23 Leader of Tomorrow by Collinsville Community Collaboration (C3).

» CHS is the only public high school in southwestern Illinois to offer Latin as a World Language course. Teacher James Stark was recognized as Illinois Latin Teacher of the Year and Illinois Junior Classical League Latin Teacher of the Year. In 2021-22, CHS Latin students earned 66 individual state or national awards for academic and creative abilities.

» A state-of-the-art STREAM (Science Technology Reading Engineering Art and Math) resource room is located at Webster Elementary for use by all CUSD elementary schools.

» Project Lead the Way STEM program is at Collinsville High School and Collinsville Middle School. Dorris Intermediate School has an after school STEM program and hosts monthly STEM nights for students and families. Science, Technology Engineering and Math are the focus of district-wide 3rd Grade STEM Day at CHS presented by district Science Vertical team and CHS STEM Club.
