Mr. Leunig reported that the Federal Jobs Bill was passed and signed into law. Each state must apply to receive the money. New York State has already applied. Senator Schumer believes that Copiague will receive \$1.4 million. This equates to about 40% of the money the Governor had cut in educational aid. At this time, there is no guidance on how the money can be spent except that the money has to be spent on jobs in education. Mr. Leunig noted that there will be a discussion on how to utilize these funds at the Administrative Council Meeting. Finally, Mr. Leunig reported that there is still no word on Pre-K funding.
