Mr. Leunig began his report with reflecting on the current budget situation in Albany. The Governor has recently directed all state agencies to cut their budgets by an additional 2.5%. They had already been directed to cut their budgets by 10%. This will be the third year in a row of deficit budgeting for the District. Mr. Leunig reminded everyone that despite the cost containment efforts the District has made already, our operating expenses continue to climb and our revenue side of the budget cannot keep up with the expenses that drive the budget, which will become exacerbated by the newly enacted property tax levy cap. This will result in the District having to dig deeper into its reserves and likely make further cuts, including staffing. Due to the dire circumstances that the District will face, the Board has adopted, for the first time, an expanded budget planning calendar which over the next few months will focus on the budget situation and multi-year planning. These meetings will be advertised on the website, electronic signs, letters home to the parents, Copiague Weekly and through a ConnectEd message. The first budget work session is scheduled for Monday, November 21 at 7:30 p.m. in the Middle School cafeteria.
