8. Superintendent's Report:

Mr. Leunig announced that the Middle School Girls Track, Middle School Boys Lacrosse, Junior Varsity Softball, Varsity Softball, Girls Varsity Lacrosse and the Girls Junior Varsity Lacrosse teams won the Sportsmanship Award for the Spring 2013 season. Mr. Leunig also reported on a meeting he attended in Schenectady regarding becoming part of a potential filing of a federal Civil Rights Complaint against New York State, making the argument that low wealth, majority minority schools are being disparately treated with respect to aid to education.
