The meeting was preceded by Superintendent's Art Gallery and Student Recognition.

Meeting was called to order at 7:40 p.m. by Mr. Michael L. Greb, President, in the Middle School Auditorium, with the opening exercises and a moment of silent meditation.

Roll Call of Board Members by the District Clerk.

#### SPACE AND FACILITIES ADVISORY COMMITTEE PRESENTION

There was a presentation given by the Space and Facilities Advisory Committee. Mr. Leunig and Mr. Michaelsen began by reviewing a timeline going back to January 2012 when the Board was presented with the Building Condition Survey, up to the present – updating and repairing infrastructure and taking a look at additional space due to enrollment growth. Mr. Brady from Wendel Architectural/ Engineering Services reviewed the Classification of Needs (infrastructure). Ms. Conhiser-Uy, Architect, reviewed the space issues for our growing population and the need to update spaces for 21<sup>st</sup> century learning. She presented three different "test fit" models, including proposed costs for each. Each Principal reviewed their existing floor plans as well as the proposed floor plans showing new spaces and updated learning environments. This is all contingent on whether the Board approves having a Bond Vote and then the residents of Copiague passing the Bond Vote. Mr. Michaelsen also pointed out that currently State Building Aid would pick up 75.2% of the monies spent on this project. The district would only be responsible for the remainder of the cost.

At the conclusion of the presentation there was a question and answer session.
