Superintendent's Report:

Dr. Bannon gave an update on the Capital Project. Construction is moving ahead according to schedule.

Dr. Bannon also reported that letters were sent out last week to the parents of Deauville Gardens East and West incoming kindergarteners letting them know that the kindergarteners that would have been attending Deauville Gardens East will be going to Great Neck Road and the kindergarteners that would have been attending Deauville Gardens West will be going to Susan E. Wiley. Dr. Bannon assured everyone that the kindergarteners will be placed in classrooms. The library and half the gym will be used as classrooms at Great Neck Road and Susan E. Wiley. The Principal will decide what classes will be in those rooms. Finally, below is additional information Dr. Bannon gave regarding the construction:

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- Phys. Ed. will be outside weather permitting, in the classroom or quietly in the half gym.
- Class size will be the same as in prior years. If a class goes over 30 we will put a Teaching Assistant in the room half the day.
- For Deauville Garden parents who have arrival or dismissal issues due to two bus stops or in some instances a walker and a busser we will provide teacher supervision for 20 minutes before and after school.
- PTA events will have to be arranged with the building principal with the knowledge that the library and half the gym are not available, but the Middle School and High School are available in the evenings when they don't have events scheduled.
- The place and staffing of STEM is not definite yet, but the days and times will remain the same. STEM parents will be made aware as soon as we have made a determination.
- Deauville Gardens students will have access to the field for recess and phys. ed.
- 7 classrooms at a time will be worked on at Deauville Gardens throughout the year which will require students to move once during the school year. The impact to the students will be minimal. They will leave on Friday and come back to a new classroom on Monday. Due to the moves at a point in the year Deauville Gardens East students will be housed in Deauville Gardens West. As we cycle through the 7 room switch, on various long weekends or vacations there will be asbestos abatement taking place. The abatement containment cannot be taken down until the air testing which is done by an outside testing company comes back clear.
- With regards to the construction: Great Neck Road will be complete this summer, Middle School will be complete except for the secure vestibule which will be done next summer, Susan E. Wiley will have all work done next summer, High School addition will be worked on during the school year in the evenings but no other work will be done until next summer with the exception of the locker rooms which will be done as soon as possible. Deauville Gardens additions will be worked on during the school day during the school year and will be "substantially complete" by August 2018 which means students can be placed there for 2018-2019. (how they are placed there will be discussed in the Spring)
- All of the workman have clearance to work in the district and spaces that are being worked on will be sealed off or fenced off so there will be no contact with students.
