Dr. Bannon stated that as per the Reopening Plan for grades 1-8, at mid-year parents would have the opportunity to change what their child was doing regarding being 100% remote or hybrid. Also, as per the plan that the high school students would now be able to be either 100% remote or hybrid. A survey went out to all parents in the district asking if they wanted to stay as they are or wanted to change. The commitment would be until the end of the school year. The survey is due on Friday, January 15 and a reminder will go out on Wednesday. The high school students going hybrid will have the same cohort as younger siblings in their family so that they are not going to school on different days.
