Dr. Bannon reported the high school has opened for students who wish to do hybrid learning. The transition was very smooth. These students are getting the full high school experience. Also, high risk sports have started. The athletes and staff must be given COVID tests once a week. The district has contracted with an outside company, Advanced Cardiovascular Diagnostics, to do the testing. Saturday morning 58 students and coaches were tested. They have a very impressive system of testing. It will be open to any staff member who wishes to be tested as well as athletes. Eventually, they will be getting the vaccine and will be able to vaccinate. There is no cost involved. It goes through your insurance, if you have insurance, otherwise, it is covered under the CARES Act.
