Many parents and student voiced their concerns. Some of the concerns were:

Some of the other parents voiced the same concerns about remote learning, it is not just the 8th graders but all students who are suffering. They also felt that the communications are poor and not getting any information. Dr. Bannon assured everyone that Wednesday's will be getting better.

Another parent wanted to know why the Middle School students have to sit in the same class the whole day. Dr. Bannon replied it is for the safety of the children, as per the guidance from the State. If the children were to move every desk would have to be cleaned before the next child could sit there.
