

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION

April 4, 2023

The Special Meeting of the Board of Education on Behalf of the Copiague Memorial Public Library was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by B'Ann Roth, Chief Election Inspector. Voting on the Library Budget for 2023-2024 and Trustee for the Library Board began.

A total of 106 votes were canvassed.

The results were as follows:

Proposition #1: Shall the proposed budget of the Copiague Memorial Public Library, Town of Babylon, County of Suffolk, State of New York, in the amount of \$4,209,000 for the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 be approved and shall there be the appropriation of the necessary funds to meet the estimated expenditures and requiring the levying of taxes on the taxable property of the Copiague UFSD for the support and maintenance of the public library?

Vote: 79 Yes 22 No Proposition passed.
