Following the lottery registration, a random drawing will be conducted for available UPK seats. The lottery drawing will be posted to the district website on July 5th, 2023. <u>Families will be notified by mail if they have been selected to participate in the program</u>. Students placed on the UPK program waiting list will be informed by letter as well.

You MUST bring the following documents to Registration Day:

- 1. <u>Registration form</u>. (You may download and print the form from the district website or pick it up at any district school main office or at the Central Office Reception desk.)
- **2.** <u>Proof of Age.</u> Original birth certificate, baptism record that includes date of birth and/or passport. (child must be 4 yrs. old birth date must fall between 12/2/18 and 12/1/19)
- 3. <u>Proof of Address</u>. (ONE of the following)
 - Current utility bill (ex.: PSEG, Keyspan, Cablevision, Verizon Triple Play) NO telephone bills.
 - Property tax bill
 - House mortgage statement, mortgage agreement or deed
 - NOTARIZED Landlord's Affidavit with current utility or property tax bill in Landlord's name
 - NOTARIZED Affidavit to Substantiate Residency with a current utility or property tax bill in the Homeowner's name.
- 4. Proof of immunizations & Copy of Physical.
- 5. Parent/Guardian will be asked to provide current photo ID and emergency contact information.
