CODE OF CONDUCT

DRUG AND ALCOHOL ABUSE EXHIBIT

Standards of Conduct for Students in a Drug and Alcohol-Free School Environment

The district is committed to make every effort to have a drug and alcoholfree school environment. In furtherance of this commitment, the district has adopted, in conjunction with its drug-free school environment policy, "Standards of Conduct" for students as follows:

- 1. The manufacture, distribution, dispensation, possession and/or illegal use of alcohol and/or other substances by students on the school premises or at school-sponsored events, is prohibited. The term "alcohol and/or other substances" shall be construed throughout this statement to refer to the use of all substances including, but not limited to, alcohol, inhalants, marijuana, cocaine, LSD, PCP, amphetamines, heroin, steroids, lookalikes, and any of those substances commonly referred to as "designer drugs."
- 2. The use of alcohol and/or other substances by students prior to attending school which results in the intoxication of the student while on the school premises or at a school-sponsored events, is also prohibited.
- 3. Students requesting aid and guidance in alcohol and other substance use/abuse will be dealt with on a confidential basis. Help for students will be provided through school support systems and referral to appropriate alcohol and other substance rehabilitation programs.
- 4. Compliance with the district's Drug and Alcohol Abuse policy, regulation and "Standards of Conduct" is mandatory.
