Chris Geackel is a product of the Copiague Public School system, graduating from Copiague High School in 1982. After graduation, Chris enlisted in the United States Air Force where he began his career as a Security Policeman. His overseas assignments included Turkey, Guam, Panama, South Korea, Philippines, Canada and the Netherlands. His primary duties were providing security for the world's most sophisticated military aircraft, missiles, nuclear weapons systems and military installations.

Believing that we are life-long learners, Chris decided, after 13 years in security, to work in the Education and Training field and completed technical training school in 1996. He developed and managed training programs and was re-assigned to manage the Formal Training branch where he ensured that Air Force students attended high tech training, formal military schools, and long-distance learning courses worldwide.
