Next steps:

All 2nd graders prescreened with CogAT in late spring (May/June)

- 97+ automatic and SST approval
- 90-96 GATE ID referral AB1040 form must earn 25 points on part II or score 62.7 or above on part I, (Renzulli) to qualify and SST approval

Grades 4-8 and newly enrolled or referred 3rd graders

• 25 points on AB1040 form or top 5% (score of 62.7 or above) on Renzulli Checklists for Learning Characteristics to qualify to take CogAT

Then,

- 90+ on NNAT and SST approval
- 1. Testing windows are established for September-October for 3rd-8th and April-May for 2nd grade only.
- 2. Students enrolling from another school district who indicate they were in a GATE program will be conditionally entered into the Cucamonga School District GATE program. At the next testing window, they will be evaluated for final placement.

^{*}In lieu of the CogAT, the NNAT may be used at the discretion of the GATE Coordinator. The qualifying score on the CogAT 90+ percentile and GATE ID referral AB1040 form must earn 25 points or score 62.7 or above on part I (Renzulli) to qualify and SST approval.
