

Effective Monday, March 16, 2020, all schools within the Cucamonga School District, along with other West End San Bernardino County districts, will be closed until April 6, 2020, while we evaluate the appropriate path forward with regard to the coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak. Although no confirmed cases of the coronavirus have been reported in San Bernardino County, or on any of our campuses, we are dealing with a public health crisis the magnitude of which none of us could have reasonably anticipated. We are all in uncharted waters as we work together to prevent the spread of the illness, and it has become clear that the appropriate path is to close schools to protect staff and students.

This is a difficult decision, but necessary, as we try to slow the spread of the virus.
