Dental Care at Englewood Community Care Clinic

The goal of this program is to educate on the importance of dental health and provide dental care services to pediatric clients that include:

- Screenings
- Cleanings
- Oral health instructions
- Fluoride varnish applications
- Dental sealants
- Referrals to a dental home

Adult clients that are uninsured and meet the federal poverty guideline can be provided emergency dental services that include an x-ray, limited oral exam and non-complicated tooth extraction at no cost.
