The Band Lock-in!

A Social Event on Friday, November 22nd

What: The band lock-in is for BAND STUDENTS ONLY. The purpose of the lock-in is to serve as a fun social event exclusive to band members. Students are served a pizza dinner, enjoy a live band performance by former band students “Disrupted Signal”, play sports in the gymnasium and play video games (Nintendo Switch – Mario Kart or Super Smash Brothers)/Board Games and Cards in the band room. We end the night with our annual “bottoms down volleyball”. This is NOT a mandatory event.

When and How: If your child would like to attend, they need to arrive at the bus loop gate between 7-7:30pm. There will not be supervision after school leading up to the event. The gate will be open at the latest until 7:30pm.

- Parents are REQUIRED to sign their children in at the gate between 7-7:30pm and also fill out a permission release along with up-to-date emergency contact information.
- The event ends at midnight and costs \$20. Parents that need to pay may also do so at this time. We accept cash and card.
 - Students of chaperones enter for FREE with an accompanied adult.
 - Students that had 15 supporters for the Trip Fundraiser only need to pay \$10 upon check-in.
 - Students that had 20 or more supporters for the Trip Fundraiser enter for free upon check-in.
- Please do not bring soda or snacks. We will have plenty of food and drink made available through the boosters.
 - Energy drinks are not permitted and will be sent home with a parent at the gate.
- Students may not bring video games or movies, but phones are permissible.
 - Please note, the band program and the school are not held liable if an electronic device is lost or damaged at the lock-in.
 - Phones will be locked up in the band room and marked with painters’ tape. They will be available for students for emergency use only. We want the students to socialize.
- School dress code does apply (no pajamas, short shorts, spaghetti straps, etc.). Students that arrive dressed improperly will be sent home at the gate. An administrator will be at the gate to assist with this.
- The schedule for the night will go as follows:

Time	Event
7-7:30pm	Check in at the bus loop gate, report to the cafeteria for dinner. The Band “Disrupted Signal” will perform while students dine.
8:15pm	Review the rules, guidelines, and schedule of events for the night while dining.
8:30-11pm	Students may play sports in the gym, or hang out and play video games or board games in the band room.
11pm-Midnight	“Bottoms-Down Volleyball” Tournament in the gym with ALL band members.
Midnight – 12:30am	Parents pick-up their children at the bus loop.

Chaperones: We are also hosting a chaperone meeting on Tuesday, November 19th at 6pm in the band room. Park at the front of the school and report to the band room (F Building). Please bring your driver’s license for a Raptor Scan. We must have enough chaperones or we will need to cancel the event. You can register your child(ren) and yourself by scanning the QR code.
