***This year we will be charging for replacement ID badges.**

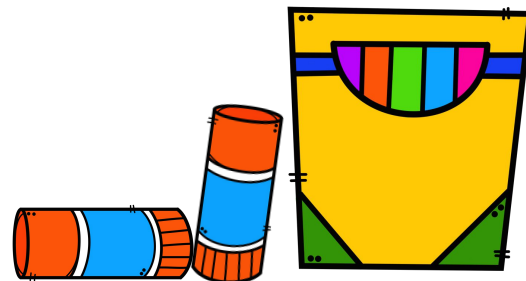
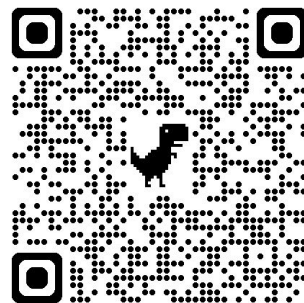
Student ID badges are to be worn by students daily. It is now part of the Student Code of Conduct : "In order to maintain a high level of student safety, students are required to wear school issued identification badges during regular school hours. Student identification badges must be worn around the neck using a **school provided** breakaway lanyard.

Liveschool

- Kingsway Elementary is a PBIS school and we use LiveSchool.
- LiveSchool is a way that we can track, reward, and improve/maintain student behavior using positive reinforcement.
- LiveSchool uses a merit (point) system to reflect L.E.A.D. expectations.
- The goal of using LiveSchool is to promote positive behavior. Students should have the opportunity to fairly earn merits frequently and spend merits just as frequently.
- Students are able to spend their points on both school-wide and classroom rewards

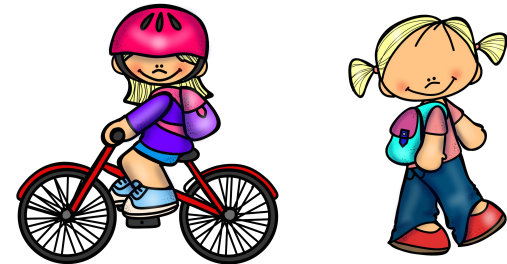
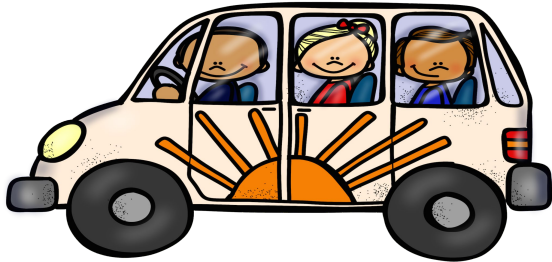


Do you want to Volunteer?

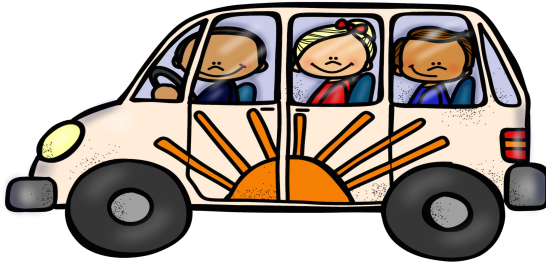
Parent Pick-up and Walker Tags
