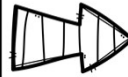

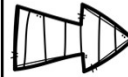

Attendance

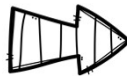
- Early Release Days – Staff appreciative of the extra time. Absences were double a traditional day. SAC feedback – no concerns among committee members.

- Upcoming Student-led Conferences October 18

- Presented annually to students, staff and families
- Mr. Troast shared the presentation with SAC that students received at the beginning of the year.

- Tier One: ROAR Expectations and Leader In Me – Tier One is for all students campus wide. Goal is to be consistent with implementation across campus.
- Positive Points – students are earning throughout the day from various staff members. Students can cash in points for class and school-based rewards. Many students looking forward to racing coach and pieing Mr. Troast.
- Data shared – referrals are higher than normal, but are coming from fewer students. Focusing on positive points awarded for positive behaviors to decrease negative behaviors.

- District Attendance Contest and Chronic Absenteeism – Data was shared and SJE is currently almost in last place. Recent decline in attendance over last few years. Some families scheduling extended trips during school year. SAC recommends sharing out school calendar frequently with families.
- Tardiness Initiative – patrols now coming in the building at 8:15. Tardy bell rings at 8:20. Students need approximately five minutes to make it from drop off to the classroom, time to unpack, and be in their seat ready to learn by 8:20. Goal: beat the patrols to class.
