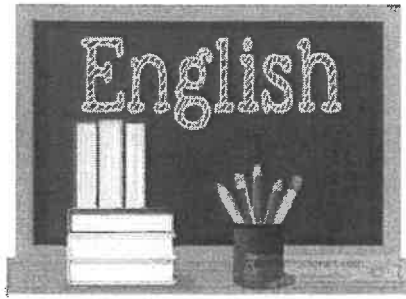
**Grade 8 Science Supply List 2023 – 2024**
