## Distinguished Alumni Group

The Distinguished Alumni Group is a means of recognizing Danbury High School Alumni who have earned distinction and in doing so have exemplified the educational and moral values most honored by our school system in areas other than athletics as listed below.

To be considered for this honor, for which a plaque will be placed in a prominent location in the school, nominees must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- 1) The candidate must have attended the Danbury School District or one of the Marblehead Peninsula Schools that formed the District. They do not have to be a graduate and should preferably be at least 35 years old.
- 2) The candidates shall have distinguished himself/herself in one or more of the following areas:
  - Education
  - Business
  - Arts
  - Political Leadership
  - Humanitarian/Philanthropic Contributions
  - Religion
  - Medicine
  - Professional Accomplishments
  - Military
  - Significant contributions to the Danbury School DistrictSpecial consideration may be given to candidates who have distinguished themselves internationally, nationally or statewide.

### Selection Guidelines and Procedures

- Nomination forms are available online at [www.danburyschools.org](http://www.danburyschools.org) and in the Board Office.
- Nominations must be returned to the superintendent of schools no later than April 24<sup>th</sup> to be considered for the current year.
- A selection committee shall review all nominations and make the final selection.
- All persons making nominations shall be informed of the final decision.
- Nominations shall be carried for one additional year following initial submission.
- Inductees shall receive a plaque that commemorates their induction.
- The Danbury Board of Education and/or private sources shall fund the cost of the plaques.
- The induction ceremony shall take place during the Danbury High School graduation ceremony.
