Transportation

Report / discussion was held on staffing for the remainder of this school year and the fall of the 2019 -2020 school year.

Van usage was at about 6,000 miles per van.

New bus will be arriving sometime in July.

Cafeteria

Due to the over \$150,000 deficit in Food Services an assessment was completed by Carrie Beegle (Carrie has been a food service director for 23 years and is currently the OASBO Vice President) in order to have a direction in shrinking the amount we are presently in the red. Key points in her report:

- 1) Current commodity usage is low. Start with \$16,863 remaining \$7,821.
- 2) Current meals per labor hour is 10.29. The average for a school our size is usually 17 – 21 meals per labor hour. To bring the meals per labor hour to this manageable amount, it would be fair to say you could cut the labor force.
- 3) Also suggested, was to look at improving the quality of the food in order to entice more students to eat.

David Taylor also stated the problem with students not having enough time to eat. Ideas were discussed on how to make the process more efficient.
