- Trash pick-up at East Harbor State Park
- Work at Danbury Food Pantry (St. Paul Lutheran Church)
- Work at Seed Faith Food Pantry (Gypsum 419-732-2399)
- Donate Blood (counts as 1 hour)
- Help with Daisy Days 5K Run in May
- James Park Clean up
- Help coach a youth athletic group (baseball, softball, soccer, basketball, volleyball, etc.)
- Participate in the "Staff vs Student" basketball PTCO Fundraiser (counts as 1 hour)
