HOMEBOUND INSTRUCTION

POLICY 4327

Homebound instruction is a service provided to students who are unable to attend school due to medical, emotional or disciplinary problems. Elementary students receive instruction for one hour per day. Students receive credit for their work while on homebound instruction. Such instruction will be provided to the student as prescribed by law. Elementary students on homebound instruction will receive at least five (5) hours of instruction per week. To the extent possible, at least one (1) hour of instruction will be provided each day.

The School District makes provisions for homebound instruction upon referral from the Medical Director or the Assistant Superintendent for Pupil Personnel Services following the guidelines established by the Superintendent of Schools or his/her designee for placing a student on homebound instruction.
