

Introduction:

It is the purpose of the East Quogue School District to operate our school in a manner that will provide for the welfare and safety of all students who attend the schools within the district. In accordance with that purpose, we will implement district disciplinary procedures which require students to conduct themselves in an appropriate manner in order to facilitate a positive learning environment for themselves and other students, whether in person or online according to the districts code of conduct 5300. These standards for behavior require students to respect each other and school district employees, to obey student behavior policies adopted by the Board, and to obey student behavior rules established within the district.

The school's primary goal is to educate, not punish. However, when the behavior of an individual student comes in conflict with the rights of others, corrective actions may be necessary for the benefit of that individual and the school as a whole. Accordingly, students shall be governed by procedures, regulations, and rules set forth in this Code of Conduct.
