



# Ira Schwartz Scholarship

Four \$500 Awards
Eligibility Criteria

To be considered for an Ira Schwartz Scholarship, the student must be able to:

- . Plan to attend college in the fall of 2020
- . Demonstrate financial need
- . Submit a personal narrative to explain the financial need and/or the adversity faced
- . Include two letters of reference—at least one of which must be from a high school administrator, counselor or teacher
- . Attach an official transcript attesting to being in good standing with at least a 3.0 average

# **Application Process**

Go to www.liASCII.org between November 1, 2019, and January 31, 2020, and complete the online application.

All scholarships will be awarded at the Annual Spring Conference on March 6, 2020.
