

Current Sophomore Credit / Registration Information

It is time to plan for registration. A few things to consider when you register: **You will be auto scheduled through the Skyward system with the classes you request in registration.** Make sure you register for the correct SIX courses. You will be held to these choices. Ensure you also select alternates to your first choices to get the classes you want. Otherwise counselors will fill schedules with what is available.

Registration will be open through Skyward Family Access February 28th - March 5th.

There are certain requirements that each 11th grade student should take in order to stay on track for graduation. **It is your responsibility to make sure you are on track for graduation.** These requirements are as follows:

- 1 year Junior Lit & Comp or AP English Language/Literature
- 1 year Math
- 1 year US History or AP US History
- 1 year Science
- 1 semester Consumer Family Issues (in 11th or 12th grade)
- 1-2 Other required courses or electives - PE, Career & Technical Education (CTE), Art/Music, World Language, etc.

Be sure to register for failed or missed required courses. Your counselor will update your schedule accordingly if courses are missing. It is your responsibility to make sure that you are meeting all graduation requirements.

Keep in mind that in order to attend most four year colleges or universities, you will need to complete a "core" of classes by the time you graduate from high school. These classes mirror our high school graduation requirements with a few exceptions. These classes include:

College Core

3 years Math (including Alg II)
2 years lab Science (including chemistry or physics)
3 years History/Social Studies
2 years World Language
1 year Fine or Performing Arts
Quantitative Course senior year
