Current Freshmen Credit / Registration Information

It is time to plan for registration. A few things to consider when you register: You will be auto scheduled through the Skyward system with the classes you request in registration. Make sure you register for the correct SIX courses. You will be held to these choices. Ensure you also select alternates to your first choices to get the classes you want. Otherwise counselors will fill schedules with what is available.

Registration will be open through Skyward Family Access March 6th-12th.

There are certain requirements that each 10th grade student should take in order to stay on track for graduation. It is your responsibility to make sure you are on track for graduation. These requirements are as follows:

- 1 year Sophomore English or Sophomore English Honors or AP English Language
- 1 year Math
- 1 year Biology or Agricultural Biology
- 1 year World History or AP World History
- 2 Other required courses or electives Fitness, Career & Technical Education (CTE), Art/Music, World Language, etc.

Be sure to register for failed or missed required courses. Your counselor will update your schedule accordingly if courses are missing.

It is never too soon to begin planning for college. Keep in mind that in order to attend most four year colleges or universities, you will need to complete a "core" of classes by the time you graduate from high school. These classes mirror our high school graduation requirements with a few exceptions. These classes include:
