Dear Parent:

In connection with their class instruction, children make planned trips to different places of educational value during the year. These trips are planned so that the children may learn under the direct supervision of the teacher and other adults who make the trip.

Every possible precaution is taken to insure the safety of the children but since the trips are away from the school, there is an element of risk involved. In most instances, school buses are used.

When private automobiles are taken, an attempt is made to get parents with children making the trip to take them. The district carries public liability and property damage insurance, but like private automobile insurance, it is effective only in cases of proven negligence.

Only children with properly signed permits are allowed to make such trips. The school believes the experience is valuable enough to warrant making the trips. It recognizes your right as a parent to decide whether you wish your child to go. If you approve of your child making such a trip, as indicated below, please sign and return this permit.
