<b>JOB SUMMARY:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>·Inspect, diagnose, plan painting projects, and performs lead worker duties over several crews of painters.</li> <li>·Provides technical assistance and training to other painters or crews of painters.</li> <li>·Receive, prioritize and schedule painting projects including estimating resources, supplies, and cost. Insure that equipment and supplies are maintained.</li> <li>·Train and perform other lead worker responsibilities overseeing the work of painter crews. Inspect projects to ensure work quality and cost efficiency are complied with.</li> <li>·Perform all responsibilities of painters as assigned.</li> </ul>	
<b>QUALIFICATIONS:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>·Experience equivalent to a journey level painter with additional training and experience in project estimation, management, and safety.</li> <li>·Knowledge of project estimating, coordination, and controlling with the ability to prioritize work assignments, schedule and organize work crews.</li> <li>·Comprehensive knowledge of the methods and techniques of surface preparation, paint application, and characteristics of different types of paints and protective coverings.</li> <li>·Possession of a valid State of Oregon driver's license.</li> </ul>	
<b>ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:</b> (Constantly over 2/3 time, Frequently 1/3-2/3 time, Occasionally under 1/3 time, Rarely under 10% time)		
<b>Physical:</b>	<p><b>Standing/Walking:</b> Constantly; throughout shift on all types of surfaces, uneven terrain, indoors and outdoors up to 1/2-2 miles per shift depending on assignment.</p> <p><b>Sitting:</b> Occasionally; in vehicle or on floor while working at or near ground level.</p> <p><b>Lift/Carry:</b> Frequently, 1-25 lbs.; tools, equipment, supplies; occasionally up to 50-65 lbs., buckets of paint, equipment; carrying short distances; rarely, 75 lbs.; equipment, carrying up to 150 feet.</p> <p><b>Push/Pull:</b> Frequently, exerting 1-35 lbs. force; using both hands/arms while using hand tools, scraping/sanding, moving equipment.</p> <p><b>Climbing/Balancing:</b> Frequently/Constantly; on stairs, ladders, scaffolding and standing on roofs while performing duties; heights up to 35 feet.</p> <p><b>Bending/Twisting:</b> Constantly; at waist/knees/neck while preparing surfaces, spraying, brushing, or rolling paint.</p> <p><b>Kneeling/Crouching:</b> Occasionally; while prepping surfaces or applying paint at or near ground level.</p> <p><b>Hands/Arms:</b> Constant use of both hands/arms in reaching/handling/grasping/fingering/squeezing while using sprayers, rollers, brushes to apply paint, prepping surfaces, etc.; can be highly repetitive; may require working with arms extended or overhead for long periods.</p> <p><b>Sight/Hearing:</b> Constantly; in performing painting duties and in maintaining a safe work environment; visual requirements include color vision, hand/eye coordination and visual acuity in near/mid range vision.</p> <p><b>Speech/Hearing:</b> Constantly; in communicating with customers, coworkers, and supervisors.</p>	
<b>Mental:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>·Constant mental alertness, attention to detail, and accuracy required in preparing surfaces and applying paint or other coatings according to specifications and in maintaining a safe work environment in potentially hazardous conditions.</li> <li>·Must be able to plan/organize work in order to complete all assignments in a timely manner.</li> <li>·Must be able to work independently, without direct supervision.</li> <li>·Must possess basic mathematical skills and ability to read/write/speak English.</li> <li>·Must be able to read and understand instructions, MSDS, work orders, and complete logs and forms.</li> <li>·Must possess good oral communication skills in order to deal with customers, supervisors, and journey level painters in an effective and professional manner.</li> </ul>	
<b>WORK CONDITIONS:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>·Work is performed indoors or outdoors under all types of conditions.</li> <li>·Hazards: Exposure to moving mechanical parts, sharp objects, toxic/caustic chemicals, odors/fumes, dust, extreme heat/cold due to adverse weather conditions, slippery surfaces, asbestos.</li> <li>·Equipments Used: Paint spraying equipment, power washers, paint brushes, rollers, , wire brushes, scrapers, sanders, ladders/manlifts/boom trucks, hand tools; safety equipment including gloves, safety shoes, safety glasses, eye/hearing protection, safety harness, protective clothing, face masks, and respirators.</li> </ul>
