Alternate School Closure Option: Close Adams Elementary School

At the January 5 Board work session, you asked that staff prepare an alternate school closure option that closes Adams Elementary School as a neighborhood school.

Attached is the staff's comparative analysis of building characteristics, student demographics, impacts and other considerations related to the two options presented for your consideration:

- Close Parker and close Crest Drive. Move Charlemagne French Immersion to the Parker building. Adams remains open.
- Close Adams. Parker and Crest Drive remain open. Move Charlemagne French Immersion to the Adams building.

My recommendation and is detailed in the Board report and recommendations.
