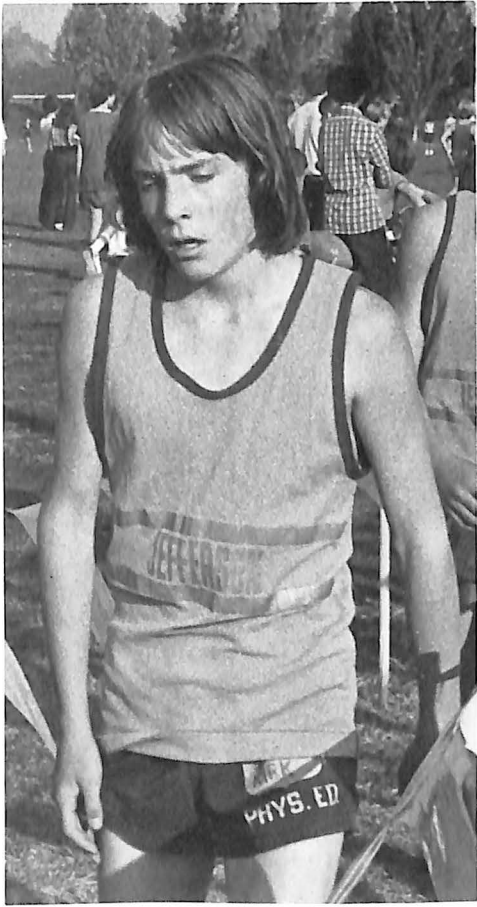


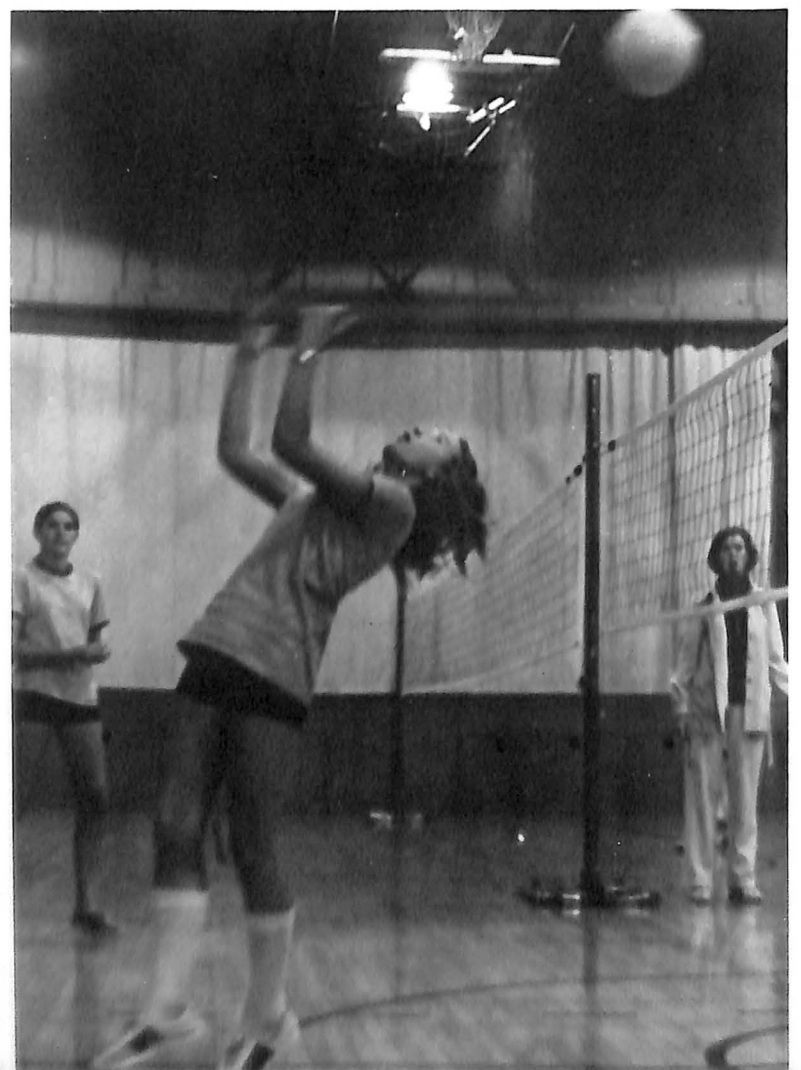
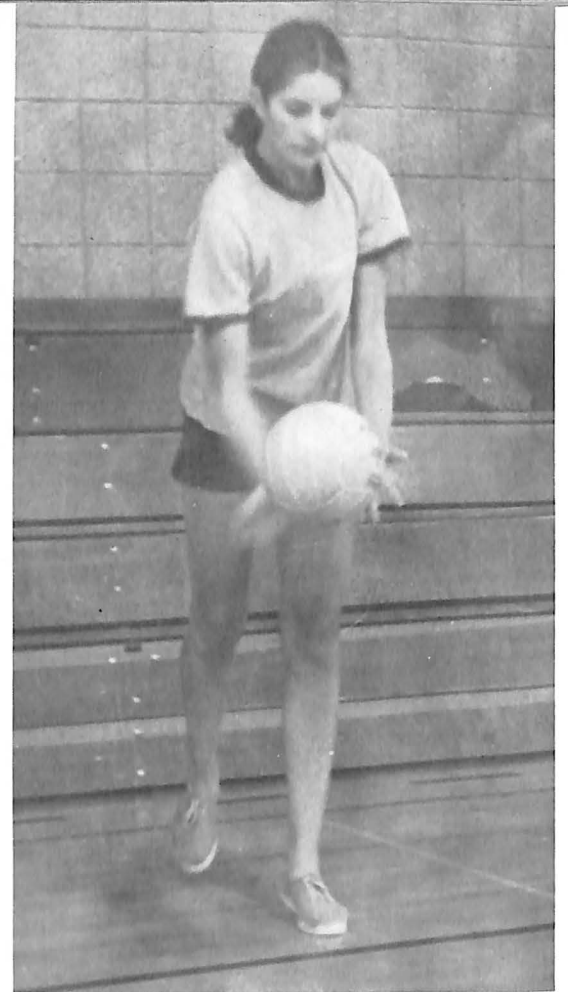
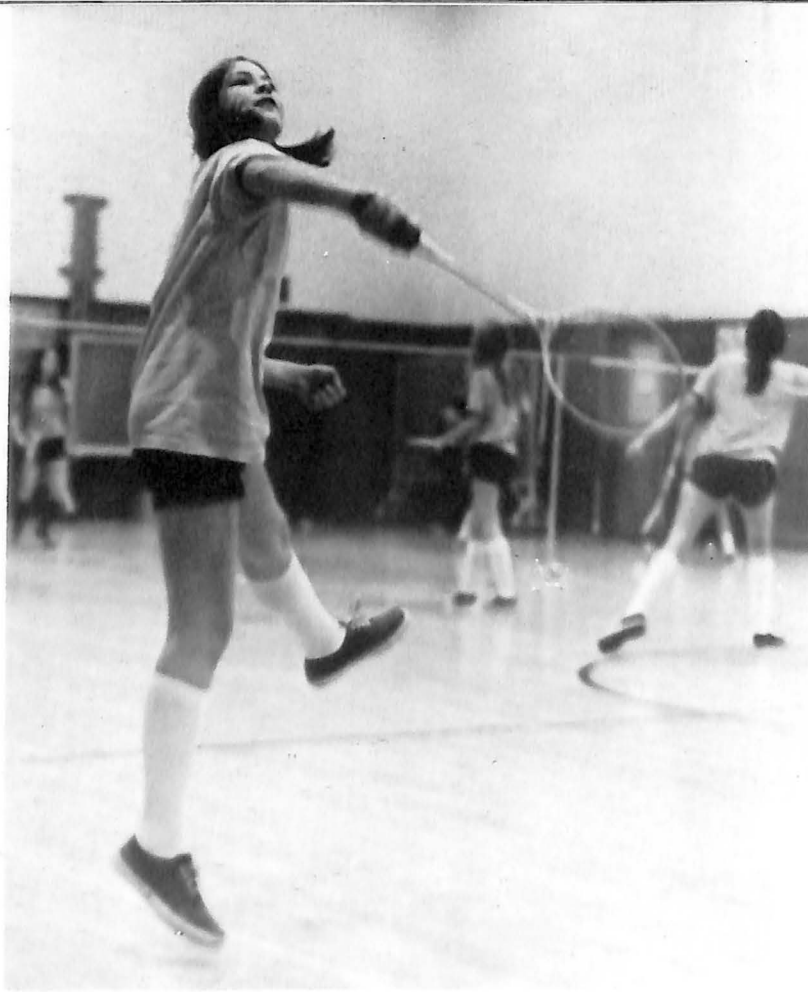


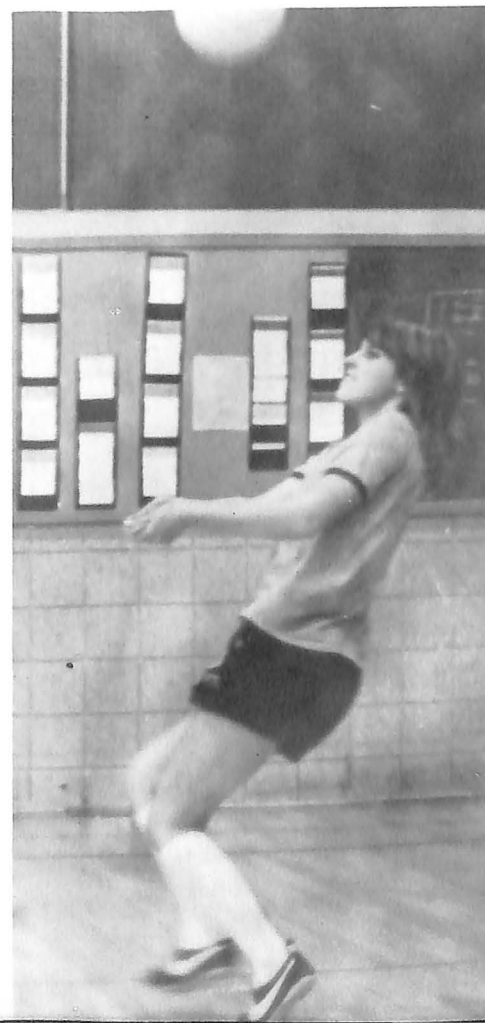
Cross Country

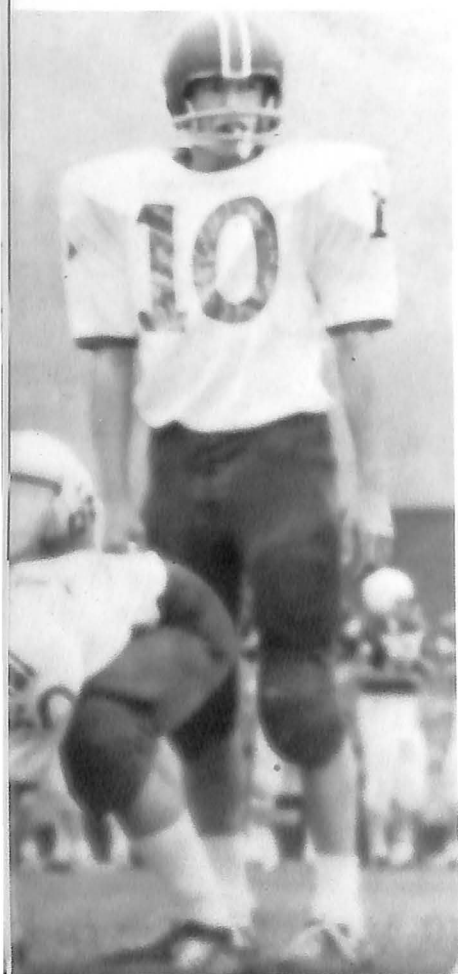

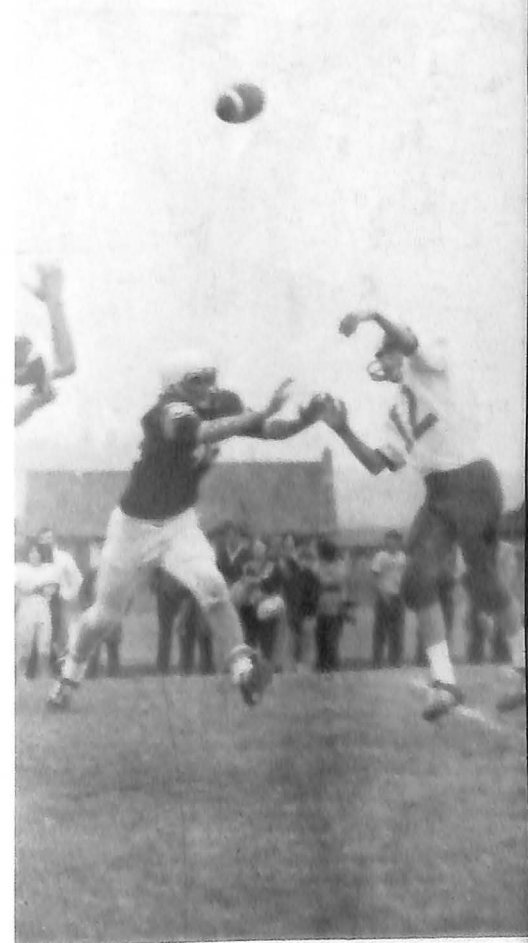

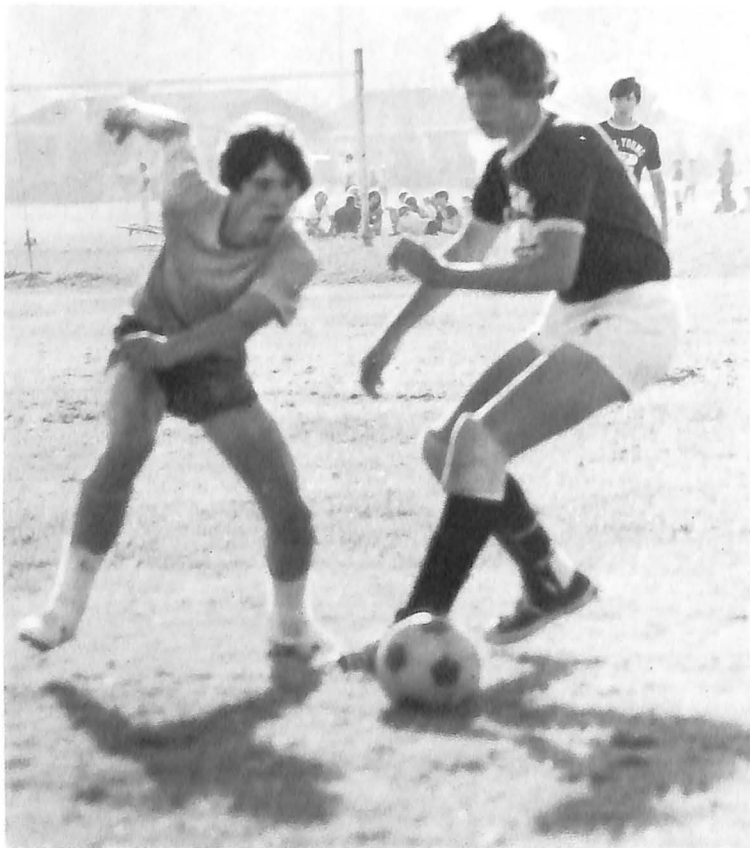


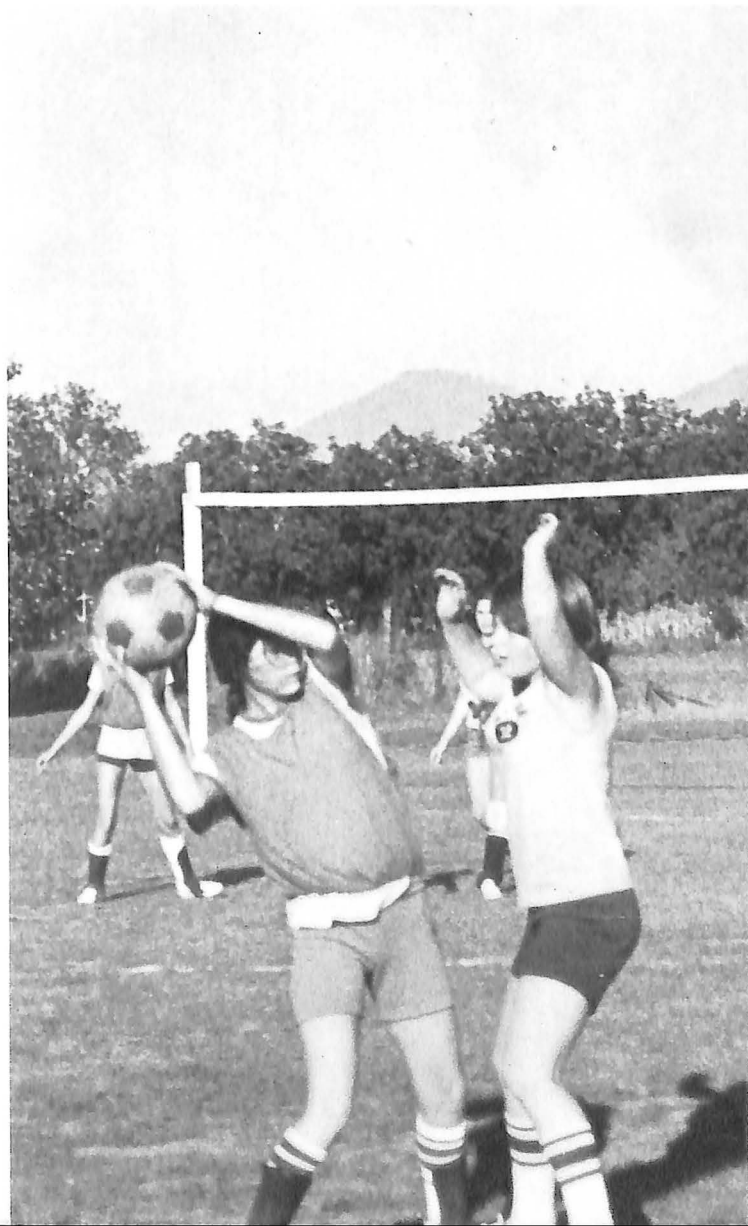


Football

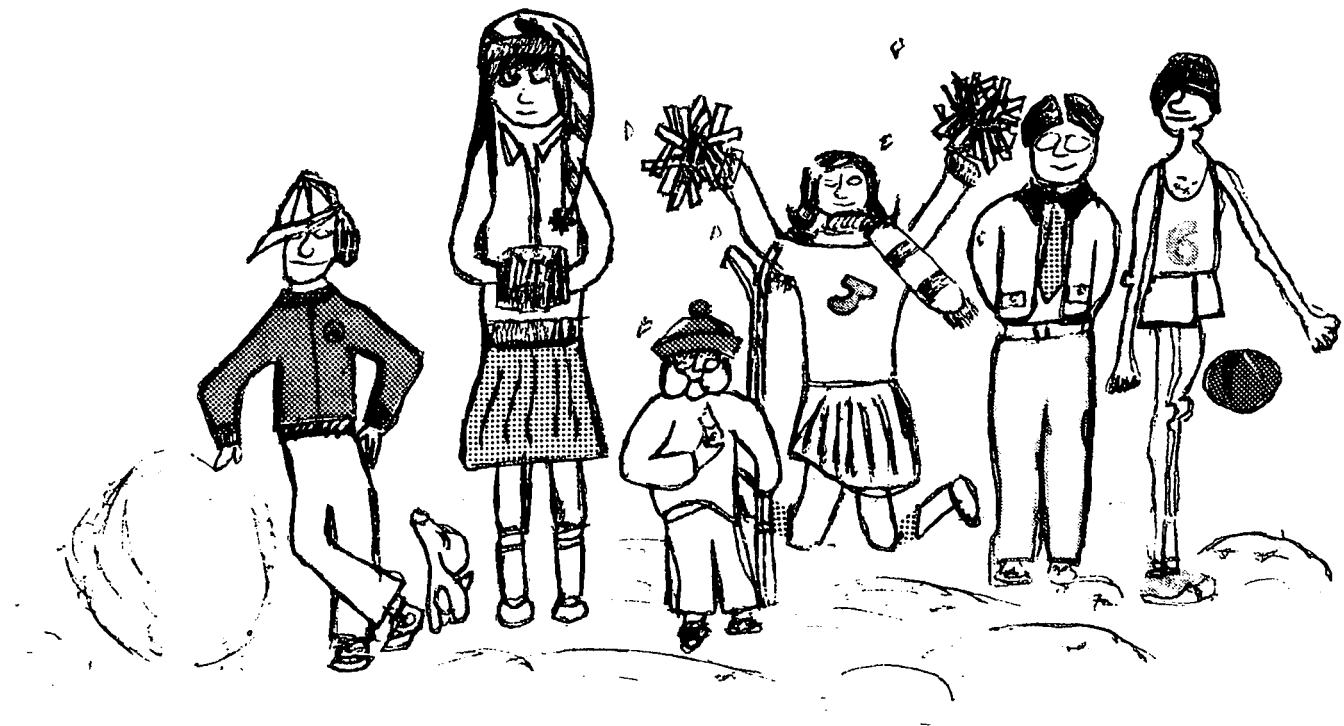
