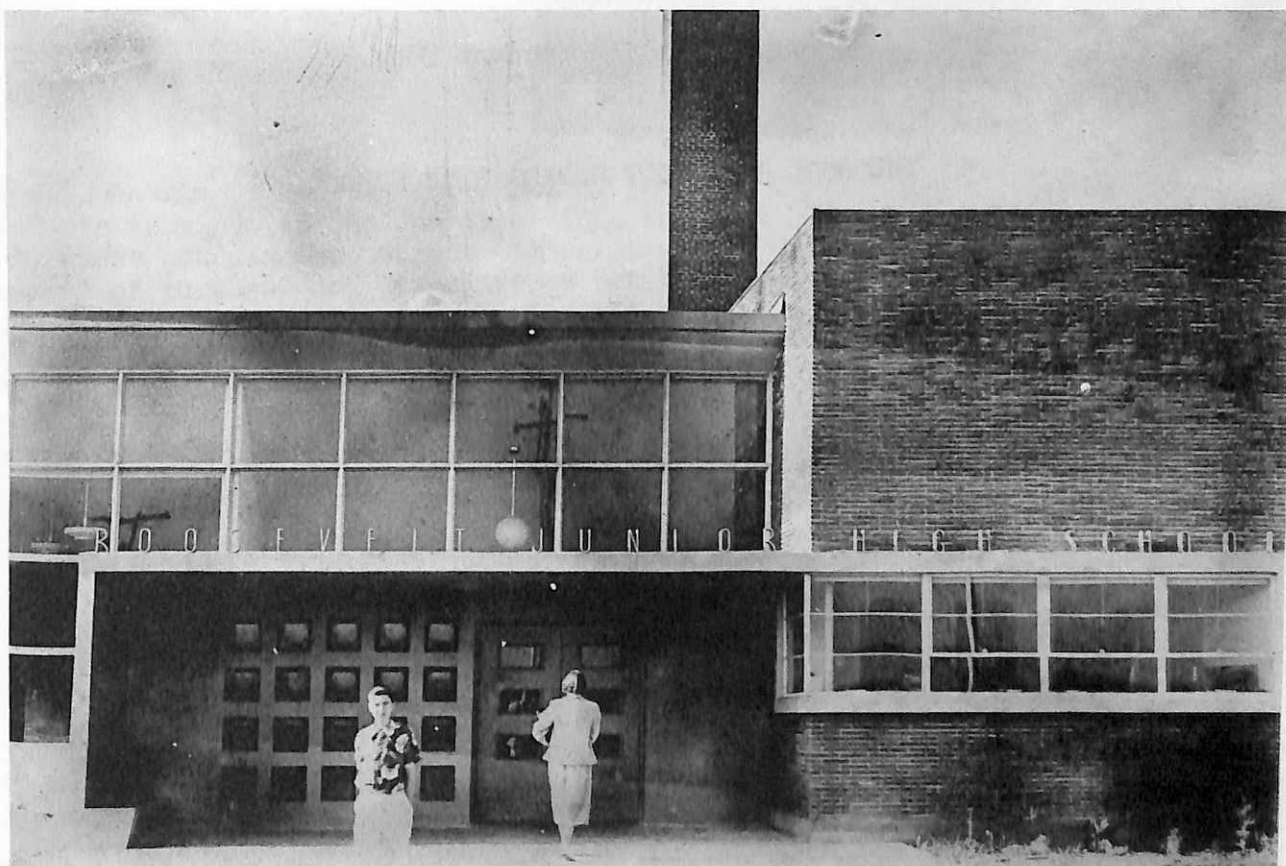

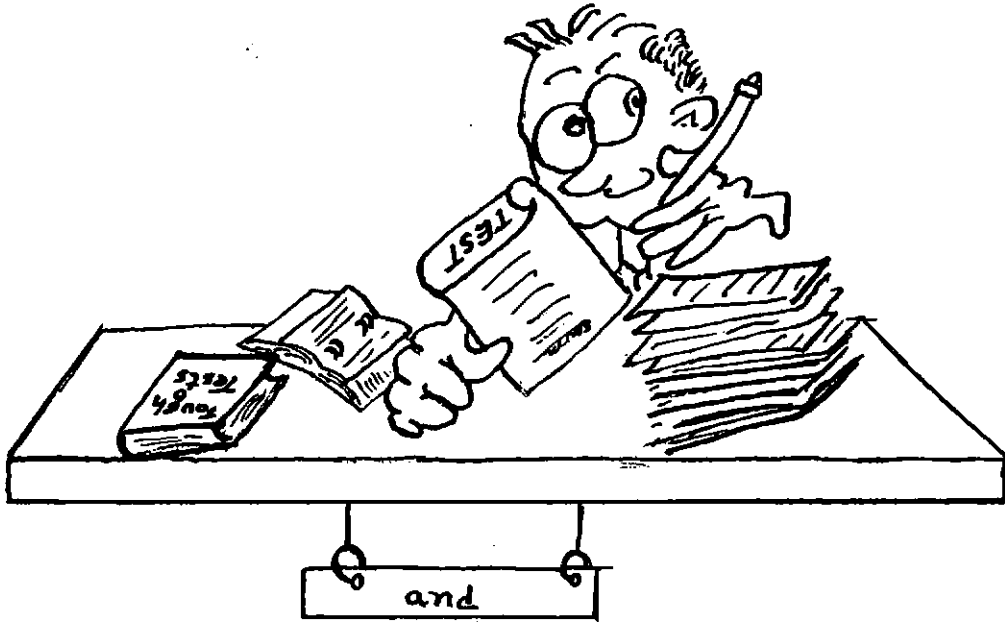

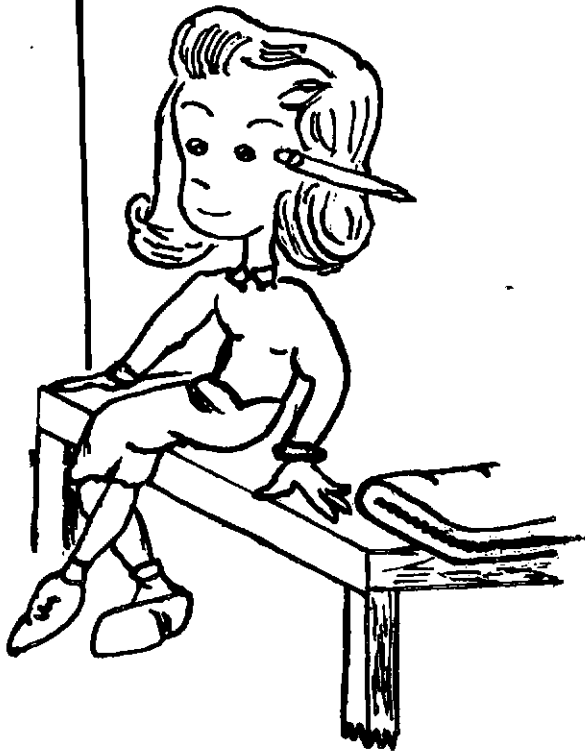
PREFACE ..
